RE: TechLite® Insulation

TechLite® foam moisture resistance:

TechLite® foam will not be permanently damaged by accidental water ingress to the insulation system. After drying, TechLite® may be re-used and still maintain all the original insulation performance including thermal values, low smoke and fire properties as well as fit tolerances. If the foam was contaminated by solvents, oils, caustics etc. we do not recommend re-use.

An unexpected rainfall is the most common way TechLite insulation gets wet in the field. As long as no physical damage has occurred, the foam will dry and be re-usable with no loss of performance. Open the boxes and expose the foam to as much sunlight, warm air and air flow as possible. Some user have set the carton on its side and opened both ends. They then used a box fan to force air through the tubes overnight or longer as needed. *You must be sure the insulation is completely dry before installation.*
